It's your swing chair; your hammock; your hanging garden seat; It is whatever you want. At work, or in the office.




CACOON was designed by a team of professional sail makers and experts in fabric and textile technology for architectural structures. It was originally commissioned as a relaxation solution for the UK's Scarlet hotel to complement the coastal location and eco-aspirations of this luxury spa in Cornwall.

The inspiration

This natural new experience actually comes from nature itself. It's a concept inspired by the beautifully stitched together hanging nests of the weaver bird. The designers saw these amazing structures in Mexico and by the time their flight landed in London the Cacoon was born.

For this little bird it creates a safe bolt-hole in the jungle; for you it creates your own personal space. You're hidden away and sheltered, relaxed and relaxing, still aware of the sounds and sights around, but cocooned alone, or together, in your own private world.

How we make the CACOON ?

As you'd expect, all our products are made to very exacting standards. We use top grade fabrics, developed for the high demands of the marine and camping industries. A mix of cotton and polyester help retain the soft feel of natural canvas while achieving the longevity of a technical fabric. Each Cacoon is treated for anti-mold, UV protection and water resistance.



CACOON is safe and strong, simple yet quirky. It's small enough to carry, yet big enough to share. From wind and wet to sun and sea, its high quality, weather-proof fabric resists all the elements. It's been tested and hung in every type of environment – in the garden, on a hike, in the woods, by the coast, in the office, in sports and leisure centers, in bedrooms and dens, in hotels and adventure playgrounds – inside and out, just hanging out and giving people a lot of fun.


THE SINGLE CACOON

At $\text{Ø}1.5\text{m}$, the single Cacoon hanging chair is our most popular size, inside or out – just **perfect for a single** adult to escape the stresses of the day. Picture yourself hanging out, totally relaxed and slowing the pace of life right down.



But wait; do you have kids? Then you've got a fight on your hands. You'll never keep them out of it. Your Cacoon will quickly become their Cacoon... but hey, that's life. You might get



you'll have no shortage of willing companions. In fact, you'll probably be fighting them for Cacoon-time.


If it comfortably holds two adults, imagine how many kids could clamber in. So you may want to hide it when your kids' friends visit (or make sure what you hang it from will support their weight).


THE SINGLE OR DOUBLE BUG NET

Keep those nasty, biting, blood suckers at bay.

The Bug Net slips over the top of your Cocoon, falling down over the entrance to keep your Cocoon a bug free space.

To keep the Bug Net in place, a length of natural coir rope is sewn into its hem. The weight of the rope keeps the net in place in anything less than a stiff breeze.

And if it's a really windy day?
As far as we know, bugs will be blown off-course anyway - so you're safe.



TREE LOOP

The Cocoon loves trees and so do we.

So, if you're planning to hang your Cocoon from a tree branch, please consider using a Tree Loop to stop bark damage.

They're 1 metre long, made from 50mm wide, 1500kg BL soft webbing, with double box stitched loops at both ends.

Our Tree Loops are easy to use and easy on your tree.

TRIPOD STAND

Nowhere to hang your Cacoon ?

No problem. Our cool, stylist Tripod is designed specifically to hold your Cacoon no matter what its size.

These sturdy, power coated steel stands will resist pretty much anything nature can throw at them.



TECHNICAL SHEET

Putting your Cocoon together

Tools required: NONE


- 1 Place your Cocoon on the ground with the door spread open.



- 2 Build the inner ring by slotting together the sections piece by piece whilst feeding them through the guide loops on the inside of your Cocoon.




- 3 Once you've fed the sections through all the loops, complete the rest of the ring. You may need to use a little force to align and slot together the last two sections.



- 4 Pull your Cocoon over the completed ring - using your hands and fingers to lever the final part of the fabric over the ring (the design of your Cocoon relies on the ring fitting tightly - so be prepared to use a little force).



- 5 Using reef knots, secure the last parts of the inner ring to the horizontal seam with the ties provided.



- 6 Hang your Cocoon - but before you do, check the branch, beam or bracket is strong enough to take both your weight and that of any friends who may join you.



- 7 Enjoy!

Every time you use your Cacoon you MUST

Always check that your Cacoon and its hanging system are in good condition and show no signs of damage, wear or tear.

Always ensure that you use a suitable knot to tie off your hanging rope and that your chosen hanging point is strong enough to take at least the same weight as you intend to have in the Cacoon.

Never exceed the stated load limit or hang the Cacoon higher than just above ground level (when fully laden).

Never jump into a Cacoon or use it as a trampoline or swing – the Cacoon is designed for gentle play and relaxation.

How to USE your Cacoon ?

- 1** Set the height of the ring off the ground to around that of a typical seat.
- 2** Sit down into your Cacoon just as you would if sitting down in a normal chair – you may find it helpful to use the internal rope as a handle.
- 3** Shift your body weight to suit your mood – remember the further back you move in your Cacoon the more reclined it will become.
- 4** To get out, put both feet firmly on the ground outside of the Cacoon and simply stand up just as you would if you were getting up from a normal chair – you may find it helpful to use the internal rope as a handle to pull up on.

Never use the ring edge as a step to get in or out of a Cacoon.

Never step out of a Cacoon one foot at a time – you will go one way while the Cacoon will go the other.



How to CARE for your Cacoon ?

Always tether your Cacoon when not in use – this is particularly important in high winds – and ensure that it cannot bang into walls, tree trunks etc as this will damage the fabric and potentially the ring too.

Washing Yes, your Cacoon can be washed in a washing machine! Cold wash. No bleach.

PUT THE RING BACK INTO YOUR CACOON AND HANG DRY. DON'T DRY WITHOUT THE RING IN PLACE. DON'T TUMBLE DRY. And don't even think about getting the iron out; Cacoons don't like irons! Or just simply wash your Cacoon down while it's hanging – use warm, soapy water and wash off with clean water.
